The Arc of Kentucky is sponsoring a poster contest for Elementary, Middle and High School students that depict the theme of "Everybody Counts." The contest will be held to celebrate March as Developmental Disabilities Awareness Month. The goal of this contest is to create awareness that every person, regardless of their disability, have abilities. Differences should not be a barrier to friendships or acceptance. You do not have to be the best at everything to still be worthwhile, valued and important.

Art Contest Terms & Conditions:

- Submissions are open to all students elementary through high school.
- The poster must depict the theme and should portray a positive message that intends to change the viewer's attitude, perception, and/or what they do, and how they do it toward including persons with developmental disabilities in everyday life.
- Poster Size—8 1/2 x 11 art paper
- Can use colored pencils, crayons, water colors or any medium.
- The winning entries will be determined on its originality and relevance to the topic of inclusion of individuals with developmental disabilities.
- Students name, school and grade should be written on the back of the poster.
- By entering the competition, each participant consents to the use of his/her name and artwork in educational materials, newsletters to be used by The Arc of Kentucky

Posters must be completed by: February 20, 2018. Posters will be picked up by an Arc member in your area to be brought to The Arc of Kentucky Annual Conference where they will be displayed and judged by participants on March 8th. Winners will be notified on March 16th.
